The purpose of this document is to provide some background regarding the conference arrangements and detail of the presenter’s requirements.

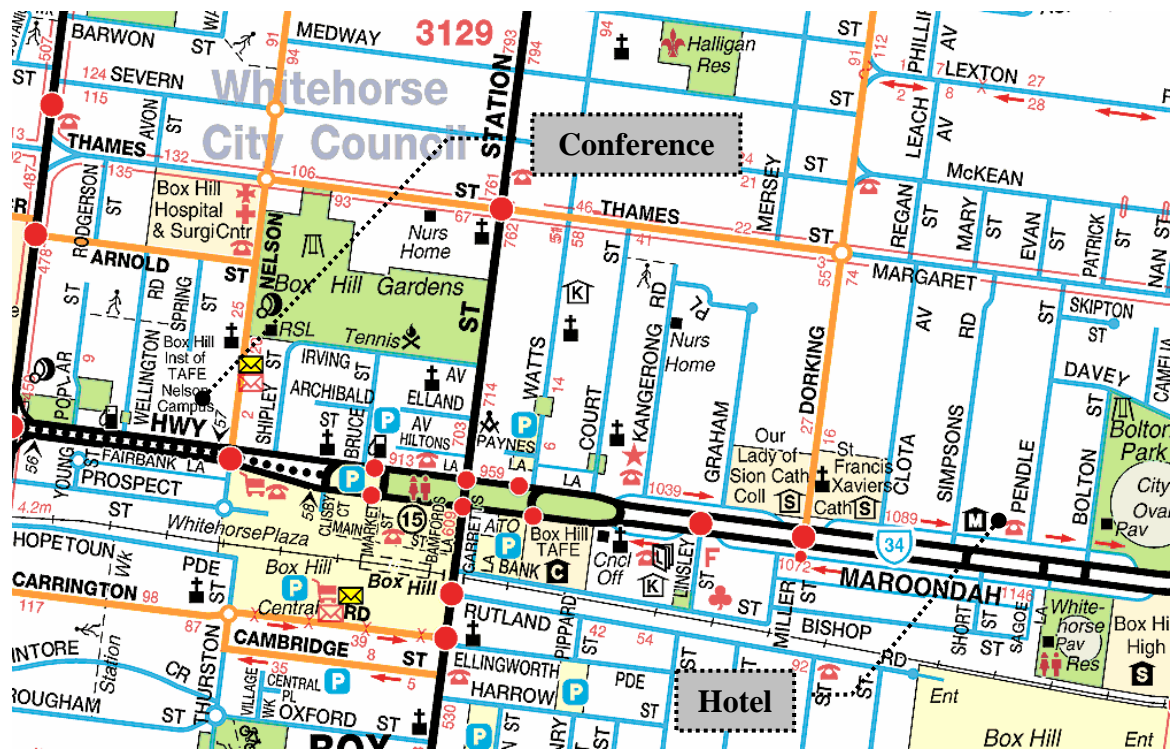
#### Locations

The plan is to present the same paper in both locations shown above with a travel day provided between venues. All presenters should plan to be in Melbourne for the first venue by the afternoon of Tuesday the 13<sup>th</sup> September 2005.

**Melbourne** with a population of over 3.5 million is the capital of the state of Victoria and is located on the northern edge of Port Phillip Bay. Some FF projects in the area include CUB Breweries and Smith Kline Glaxo, with the more recent Oil & Gas projects of Bass Gas and the Otway offshore platforms.

Time zone is GMT + 10 hours.

Melbourne weather in September has average highs of 16°C and lows of 6°C.

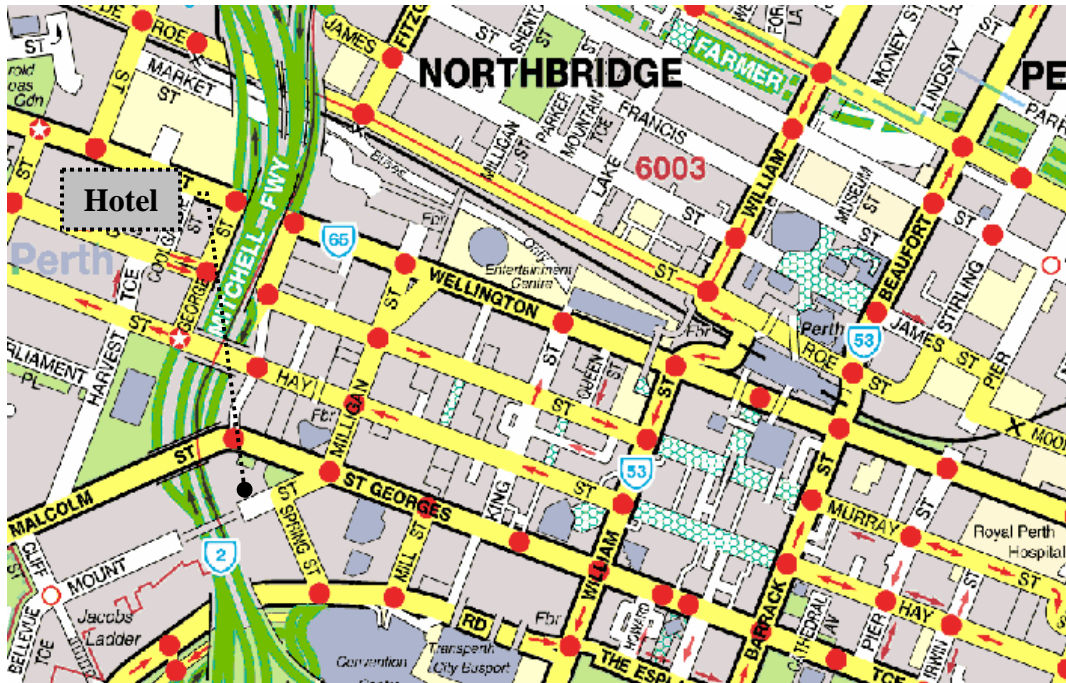


Box Hill area

**Perth** with a population of around 1.3 million people is the capital of Western Australia and is located on the Swan River 12 Km inland from the Indian Ocean. Current FF installations include the CSBP Cyanide plant and Wesfarmers LPG with the recent new projects of the BHP Billiton Ravensthorpe Nickel plant and Woodside's Northwest Shelf Enfield FPSO.

Time zone is GMT + 8 hours.

Perth weather in September has average highs of 20°C and lows of 8°C.

### **Deadlines**

An extract of not more than 200 words must be submitted by **20<sup>th</sup> May 2005** for evaluation by the technical panel prior to being accepted. The paper must be received for review by **15<sup>th</sup> July 2005**. The PowerPoint presentation and any supporting material for inclusion on the CDROM must be received by **26<sup>th</sup> Aug 2005**. Papers not meeting the technical requirements may be edited or rejected. Controversial and commercial content about any fieldbus will be strictly controlled with all papers being reviewed.

### **Travel**

As noted in the locations section above, the plan for movement between venues is detailed below. While it is the responsibility of each speaker to arrange their own transportation, the below suggestion will allow better coordination of airport taxis, room check-in, etc.
